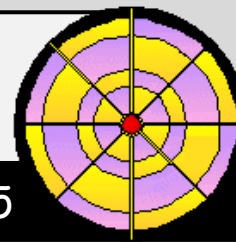

## Sun sets for final time in 2020 for Alaskan city

The sun has set for the final time this year in Utqiagvik, America's northernmost city, where residents have been plunged into darkness until January.

Residents of Utqiagvik, the Alaskan city formerly known as Barrow, saw the sun set on their hometown at 1:30 pm on Wednesday, and have to wait another 62 days before it officially rises again! This annual phenomenon is known as 'polar night', which is when the sun remains below the horizon due to the tilt of Earth. When can residents expect the sun to rise again?
